Excerpt from the current JLIR Bylaws:

“The Nominating Committee shall prepare, for election by the membership, a single slate of candidates for election to the Board of Directors. The information from the Nominating Committee shall be in the hands of the Recording Secretary and the Board 30 days before the election meeting. Additional nominations with 25 signatures shall be in the hands of the Recording Secretary 20 days prior to the election meeting. All of this information shall be in the hands of the Membership 15 days before the election meeting. The Recording Secretary shall post these additional nominees. Only candidates so nominated shall be eligible for election. The write-in candidate shall be presented with the slate at the election meeting. If a member of the Nominating Committee wishes to be considered for a position on the Board of Directors, she must resign from the Nominating Committee prior to the slate being presented to the Recording Secretary and the Board of Directors as stated above.”

“The newly elected officers shall assume their duties at the beginning of the fiscal year.”

Excerpt from the Proposed 2016-2017 JLIR Bylaws:

- A. President – The President shall be the chief executive officer of this League, shall preside at meetings of this League, the Board of Directors; and shall be an ex-officio member of all committees except the Nominating Committee. The President shall be responsible for promoting the image of this League and shall be the liaison with the community.
- B. President-Elect – The President-Elect shall assist the President, shall assume the duties of the President in her absence, and shall fulfill the unexpired term of the President upon her resignation or removal from office. She shall serve as Administrative Vice-President and chair the Administrative Council.
- C. Immediate Past President – The Immediate Past President shall provide advice and leadership to the Board of Directors regarding past practices and other matters to assist in governing the League. She shall support the President and the President-Elect on an as needed basis. She also acts as Chair of the Nominating and Placement Committee and oversee annual awards selection.
- D. Finance VP – The Finance Vice President shall collect all dues and assessments, and receive all monies, is the custodian of its funds, and shall oversee all accounting operations while working directly with the accounting/bookkeeping professionals retained by the League.
- E. Communications VP – The Communications Vice President chairs the Communications Council and oversees a communication program that shall be comprehensive, encompass publications, and maintain media relations, publicity, and advertising to create positive and professional impressions among the League and community.

- F. Community VP – The Community Vice President shall assist the President in community affairs. She shall chair the Community Council. The Committees under this Council shall be Community Research/program Development, State Public Affairs, and all community programs voted by the membership for the fiscal year.
- G. Fund Development VP – The Fund Development Vice President shall oversee all fundraising activities. She shall chair the Fund Development Council. The committees under this council shall include the Fund Development/Solicitation Committee and all fundraising committees approved yearly by the membership.
- H. Membership VP – Membership Council chair. The Council committees shall be Membership Development & Outreach, Nominating & Placement, Sustainers, Education & Training, and Membership Activities. She shall guide, mentor, and encourage Council members to help increase membership and develop better connections, education, and morale amongst the League.
- I. Sustainer Liaison – The Sustainer Liaison shall attend and serve both on the League Active Board and the board of the Sustaining Membership. She shall provide an avenue of communication between both boards and act in an advisory capacity to the Board.
